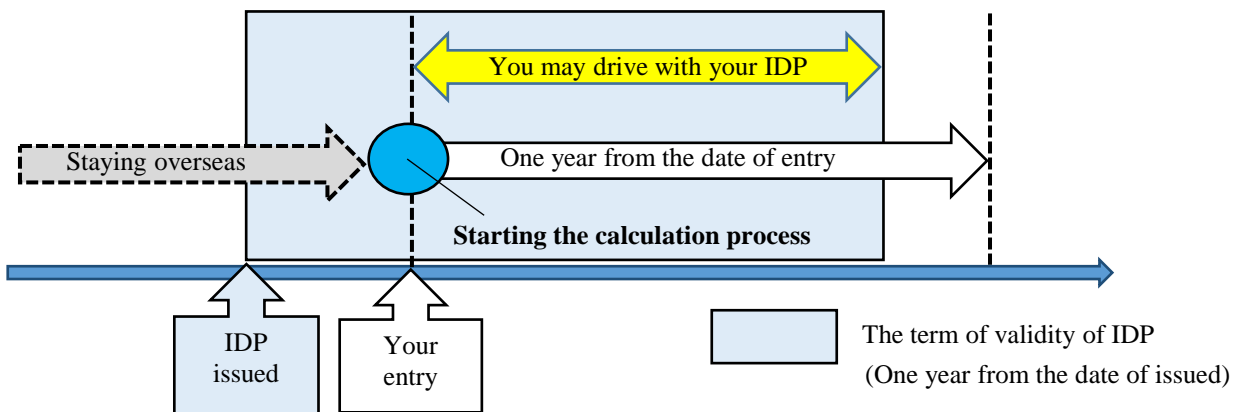


Valid International Driving Permit in Japan

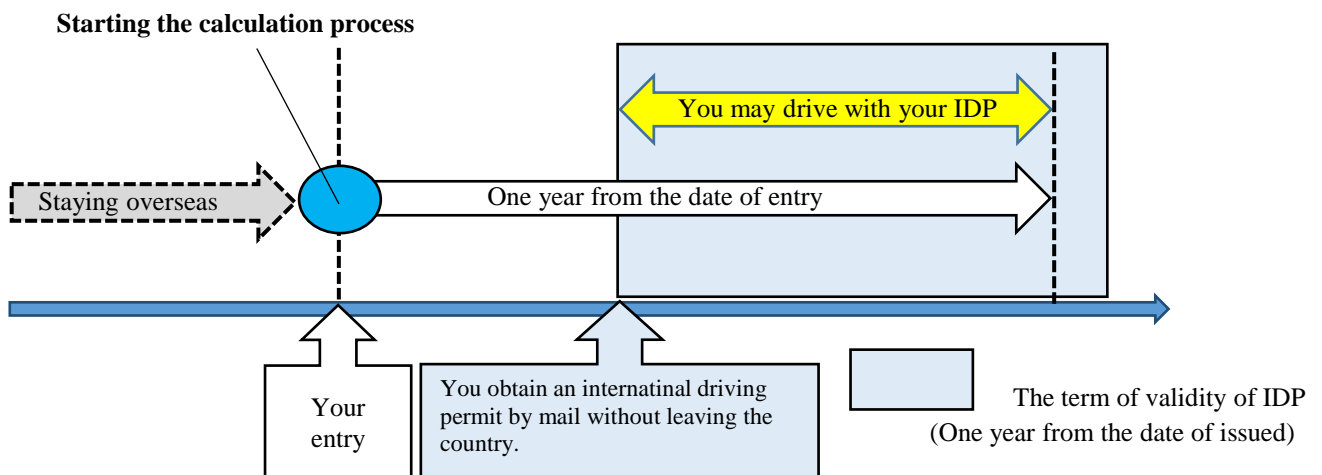
Only International Driving Permits (IDPs) issued by a signatory to the 1949 Geneva Convention in conformity with the Convention's provisions are recognized as valid for driving in Japan . An IDP on the other conventions or treaties , including the 1969 Vienna Conventions , is invalid even if it is issued by a signatory to the 1949 Geneva Convention .

In addition, the following conditions must be satisfied:

1. The IDP shall be valid for one year from the date of issue while you shall be allowed to drive with it for one year from the date of your entry into Japan .

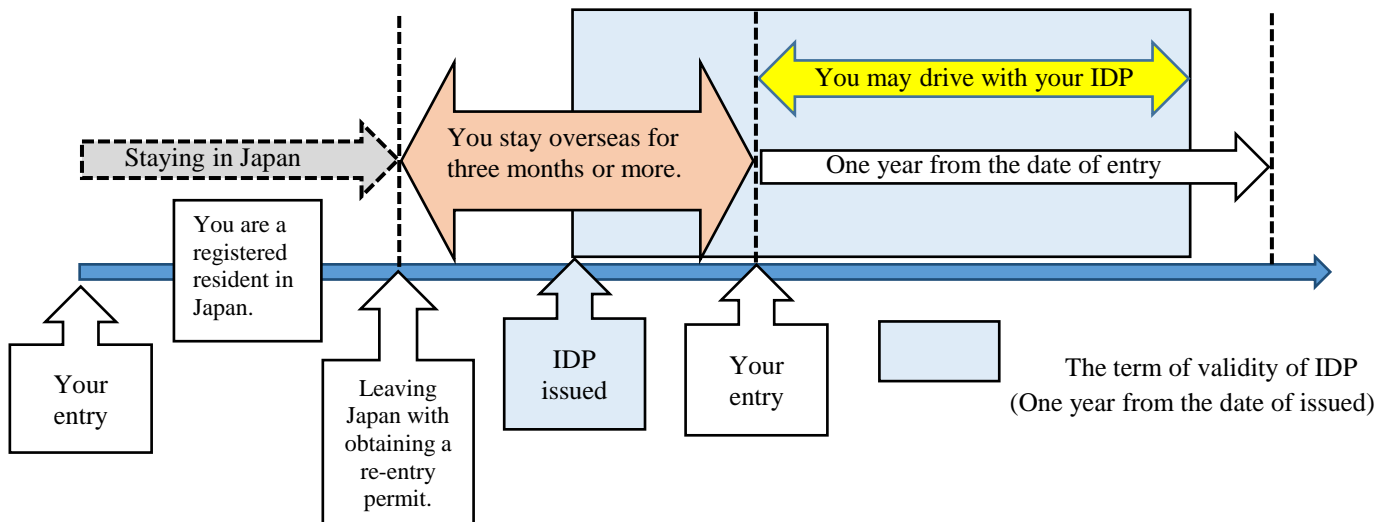


2. After first entering Japan, if you obtain an international driving permit.



3. If you are a registered resident in Japan , you shall stay overseas for more than three consecutive months before re-entry. (The Road Traffic Act, Article 107-2)

- (1) In case you re-enter Japan after staying overseas for three months or more :
You may drive with your IDP.



- (2) In case you re-enter Japan for less than three months after leaving the country:
You shall not drive with your IDP, even if it is a new one obtained while staying outside Japan.
